

ORDER REQUIRING GROUND WATER CERTIFICATION WITH CERTAIN PLATS

Whereas Section 232.0032(a), Local Government Code, as amended, authorizes a Commissioners' Court to require, for any subdivision for which the source of the water supply intended for the subdivision is groundwater, the plat application to have attached to it a statement that:

1. Is prepared by an engineer licensed to practice in Texas or a geoscientist licensed to practice in Texas and
2. Certifies that adequate groundwater is available for the subdivision

And

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has established the form and content for such certification and

Groundwater availability is a critical public health and safety factor in Mills County.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Mills County, Texas that every plat of any proposed subdivision depending on groundwater for its water supply which is submitted to the Commissioners Court for approval must contain the required groundwater certification in form and content specified by the Texas Commission.
