

Mills County Budget October 1, 2020 – September 30, 2021

This Budget will raise less revenue from property tax than last year's budget by an amount of \$10,679 which is a 0.23% decrease from last years budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$151,904.

Mills County has unpaid debt obligations of \$6,792,140.

This budget was adopted by Mills County Commissioners Court in its regular meeting August 31, 2020 with the following vote:
