This special session of the Mills County Commissioners Court opened in due form of law at 1:30 am in the Mills County Commissioners' Courtroom located at 1011 4th Street, Goldthwaite, Texas 76844.

Present in the Courtroom: Judge Pro Tem Jason Williams, Commissioners Partin, Garren, and Wright, County Attorney – Gerald Hale, County Clerk – Sonya Scott, and Treasurer – Summer Campbell. Present via Zoom: Jacki Brooks. See attendance sheet for audience listing.

1. Judge Pro Tem Williams called the meeting to order noted the presence of a quorum; Judge Pro Tem Williams led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance and opening prayer.

Pct 1 Commissioner Wright: Meeting with Rolling Oaks all week. Getting ready to move portable EMS building.


Pct 2 Commissioner Garren – grading roads last week.
