- 1. Judge Johnson called the meeting to order noted the presence of a quorum; Judge Johnson led the Pledge of Allegiance with Commissioner Williams providing the opening prayer.
- 2. Audience with Individuals none
- 3. Consider and Act on Brasher & Co. bid for Courthouse Maintenance, and related matters They will scrap out existing grass, level the ground and fill in any ruts and lay new grass. There was discussion on grass vs pea gravel by the 1888 Historical Jail. Commissioner Williams ask how pallets of grass may be needed and amount of topsoil needed as it was not in the quote from Brasher & Co.
