October 27, 2025, at 9 00 a m


This regular session of the Mills County Commissioners' Court opened in due form of law at 9 00 am in the Mills County Commissioners' Courtroom located at 1011 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Goldthwaite, Texas 76844

Present in the Courtroom Judge Jett Johnson, Commissioners Sullivan, Head, Partin, and Williams Treasurer Summer Campbell, County Attorney Bill Malone, and Sheriff Jones See attendance sheet for audience listing

- 1 Judge Johnson led the Pledge of Allegiance, and Commissioner Williams provided the prayer
- 2 Review and act on Minutes of October 13, 2025 Commissioner Williams noticed a name was wrong on item 12 Commissioner Head made the motion to approve the minutes with correction Commissioner Williams 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion Carried 5-0
- 3 There was no audience with individuals
- 4 Review and act on accounts payable Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the accounts payable with Commissioner Sullivan providing the 2<sup>nd</sup> Carried 5-0
- 5 Executive Session- Judge Johnson made the motion to go into executive session at 9 03am 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Head Carried 5-0
- 6 Executive Session ended, and court called back into order at 9 26 am
- 7 C & A on SB22 Procedures, and Compliance Reporting Summer Campbell met with Judge Johnson and talked with the State Comptroller's office The Sheriff and County Judge are slated to be the ones who complete the compliance report Summer will look into the best way to manage the accounts and what accounts the money should be kept in This will not change until the next budget cycle Sheriff Jones and Judge Johnson will work on the reports with help from Summer Campbell on the Interest accrued There was no action taken on this matter
- 8 C & A on declaring items in Precinct 2 as salvage-Commissioner Williams made the motion to declare items as salvage 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Head Carried 5-0
- 9 C&A on declaring 2004 JCB Backhoe, serial # 904377 as surplus to be auctioned off at Live Oak Auction on November 22, 2025 Commissioner Partin made the motion to declare the 2004 JCB Backhoe, serial # 904377 as surplus to be auctioned off, Commissioner Head provided the 2<sup>nd</sup> Carried 5-0

- 10 C&A on purchase order for John Deer 670G Maintainer Even ordering now, the county will not get the maintainer until next spring Commissioner Williams made a motion to get the maintainer ordered, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Judge Johnson Carried 5-0
- 11 C&A on Request for Proposal for Mills County Law Enforcement Cameras David Sons was present in the court room to answer questions Commissioner Williams made the motion to approve the Cameras, Commissioner Head provided the 2<sup>nd</sup> Carried 5-0
- 12 C&A on Resolution for CTECD regarding PSAP Interlocal Agreement -- This is something that is done Annually Commissioner Williams questioned all the blanks and whether they all needed to be filled out Some of the blanks were forms for use if needed and when needed Commissioner Williams made a motion to table this item, Judge Johnson provided the 2<sup>nd</sup> Carried 5-0
- 13 C&A on final Plat for Hoof and Horns Subdivision Surveyor Don King and Project Manager Marcus Kujawa were both present The land the Subdivision is on was also a Game Ranch for GMO deer at one point While it is no longer used for breeding purposes, it remains a drop-off location for deer This will have to have a high fence perimeter and 20-foot gates that always remain closed, this issue will be between Parks and Wildlife and Hoof and Horns Commissioner Partin brought up concerns about approximately 33 lots will have to have county road entrances and the need for tin horns and possible water drainage issues, Mr King stated that the HOA should cover the restrictions and culvert needs Judge Johnson made the motion to not approve the final Plat until issues are resolved, and the HOA and Restrictions are also presented with the Plat Commissioner Partin 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion Carried 5-0
- 14 Commissioners' Request and Reports-  
PCT 1- Changing oil and putting on new tires Working on CR 315 until it got too dry, then started working on 318  
PCT2- hauling on 312 and working on bar ditches  
PCT 3- Shredding and will try to get a couple of tin horns in this week  
PCT 4- Haul material for CR 430 and C 530 Had a blow out on the MacTruck and fuses keep blowing Will have bids for fuel and materials Some of the verbiage in the guidelines needs to be cleaned up The Ebony Community Center has applied for a \$5,000 00 grant from LCRA for new water well service
- 15 Judge's Report- No real news other than Early Voting is going on
- 16 Adjournment- Commissioner Sullivan made the motion to adjourn the meeting, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Head Carried 5-0
