This Regular Meeting of the Mills County Commissioners' Court opened in due form of law at 9 00 am in the Mills County Commissioners' Courtroom located at 1011 4th Street, Goldthwaite, Texas 76844

Present in the Courtroom Judge Jett Johnson, Commissioners Sullivan, Head, Partin, Williams, and County Attorney Bill Malone See attendance sheet for audience listing

- 1 Opening Pledge of Allegiance was led by Judge Johnson with Commissioner Williams providing the prayer
- 2 R & A on Minutes of November 24, 2025, December 8, 2025 @ 9am, and December 8, 2025, Workshop There were a few grammatical errors to be corrected Commissioner Williams made the motion to approve the Minutes with corrections, Commissioner Sullivan 2nd the motion Carried 5-0
- 3 Audience with Individuals, no one signed up to speak
- 4 C & A on Accounts Payable Commissioner Head made a motion to approve Accounts Payable, Commissioner Williams provided the 2nd Carried 5-0
- 5 Discussion on 2025 SART Biennial Report Jordan Cadenhead from the 35th Judicial District Attorney's Office was present to discuss and answer questions if there were any This report is a requirement for the grant
- 6 C & A on Procurement Policy FEMA requires this policy There was discussion on the changes in the process regarding the dollar amount, bids, and quotes Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve this Policy with Judge Johnson providing the 2nd Carried 5-0
- 7 C & A on Amending Mills County Mitigation Plan Motion made by Judge Johnson to table this item with Commissioner Head providing the 2nd Carried 5-0
- 8 C & A on Authorizing County Treasurer to Apply for Small Project Advance of Funds (AOF) Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve Authorizing County Treasurer to Apply for Small Project AOF with Commissioner Head providing the 2nd Carried 5-0
- 9 C & A on Hardware Recycling from the Sheriff's Department This is workstation equipment, docking stations, computer tower, Toughbook laptops, keyboard/mouse sets, monitors, speaker sets Judge Johnson made a motion to recycle the hardware with commissioner Head providing the 2nd Carried 5-0
- 10 C & A on Declaring Frigidaire 50 Pint Dehumidifier from County Clerk's Office as scrap Commissioner Head made a motion to declare as scrap with Commissioner Sullivan providing the 2nd Carried 5-0

- 12 C & A on Notice of Joint General Primary Election Judge Johnson made the Motion to Approve the Notice of Joint Primary Election with commissioner Head providing the 2nd Carried 5-0
- 13 C & A on Joint Resolution and Statistical Information for Joint Primary Election Judge Johnson made the motion to approve the Joint Resolution and Statistical Information for Joint Primary Election, Commissioner Head provided the 2nd Carried 5-0
- 14 C & A on Notice of Combined Precincts for Primary Election Judge Johnson made the motion to approve the Notice of Combined Precincts for Primary Election, Commissioner Head provided the 2nd Carried 5-0
- 15 C & A on Final Plat for Hoof & Horns Subdivision The preliminary plat was approved in Commissioners Court, not sure how it was overlooked but the check list was not completed Since then, everything on the check list has been completed Judge Johnson made the Motion to Approve the Final Plat for Hoof & Horns Subdivision with all fees to the County and to Surveyor Don King and Culverts installed Marcus wanted clarification on the amount due to Mr King and would like an itemized statement Marcus and Mr King had a brief discussion and Mr King stated that he would get him a bill Judge Johnson repeated his motion and Commissioner Williams provided the 2nd Carried 4-1 with Commissioner Head opposed

PCT 1- Work on CR 317, bust up material, and work on the dump trailer doors
PCT 2- The work on CR 303 is finished, now working on CR 213 and 259
PCT 3- Bridge on CR 508 should be completed by the end of the year Have put in more time on the Hoof & Horns Subdivision than probably should have, Road Hands have had no time off so as of last Friday that was their last day to work for the year, it will just be Commissioner Partin working
PCT 4- Worked out towards the Swinging Bridge, Blading on CR 550 and 549, and hauled material
- 17 Carlos Reyes contacted the Clerks office regarding surplus material and stated that Mills County can start getting this This will have to go through Commissioners Court to approve the allotment and will be put on the next agenda
- 18 Adjournment Judge Johnson made a motion to adjourn, Commissioner Head 2nd the motion Carried 5-0
