- 1 Opening Pledge of Allegiance was led by Judge Johnson with Commissioner Williams providing the prayer
- 2 Audience with Individuals Karen Wesson Francis spoke and asked the question since the project has already started why give an abatement? Red River/ Blue Heron stated that the project has not been started only ground testing
- 3 Discussion on Tax Abatement for Blue Heron Solar, LLC There was discussion on the Tax Abatement numbers Blue Heron Solar is asking for 50% and Commissioners are more open to anywhere from 0 to 30%, Jeff Allen, the attorney for Mills County in this matter will put together projected dollar amounts and percentages for the Court to go over and get a better understanding of what the County is looking at
There was also discussion of a Road Use Agreement and if it is needed Commissioner Williams wants to make sure that Mills County Roads are taken care of Blue Heron recommends a road use agreement even though the primary road that will be used is Brown County Road
