This regular session of the Mills County Commissioners Court opened in due form of law at 9 00 AM at the Mills County Courthouse at 1011 4th Street, Goldthwaite Texas, 76844

- Commissioner Williams asked what office is responsible for billing Blue Heron, Judge Johnson stated he would look into this Commissioner Partin then questioned the \$5,000 for Texas Association Risk Management, this may be a deductible, but court wants clarification Texas Workforce Commission amount was \$3740 39 on which was paid Commissioner Partin pointed out a charge for \$400 29 for PCT #1 on materials, Commissioner Sullivan addressed the court and stated it needs to be on line item for road materials instead

Commissioner PCT #3 Dale Partin – Assisted Precinct 4 with covering CR 100 and CR 500 with RAP Plan is to begin hauling dirt and blading roads depending on moisture Commissioner Partin also addressed how well the Mills County Stock Show / Youth fair was this past week and how great all the participants were in all categories

Commissioner PCT #4 Jason Williams – Assisted Precinct 3 with re-topping CR 439, have been doing tree work out by Regency Bridge CR 433 Commissioner Williams has only received two applications for road hand position that is available, in which neither have a CDL
