February 9, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.

This Regular Meeting of the Mills County Commissioners' Court opened in due form of law at 9:00 am in the Mills County Commissioners' Courtroom located at 1011 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Goldthwaite, Texas 76844.

Present in the Courtroom: Judge Jett Johnson, Commissioners Sullivan, Head, Partin, Williams, and County Attorney Bill Malone. See attendance sheet for audience listing.

1. The Opening Pledge of Allegiance was led by Judge Johnson with Commissioner Williams providing the prayer.
2. R & A on Minutes of January 26, 2026 @ 9am, and January 26, 2026, Workshop: in the Minutes for the Regular Meeting there were a couple of corrections to be made regarding a dollar amount for the Texas Workforce Commission. Commissioner Williams made the motion to approve the Minutes with corrections, and to approve the Workshop Minutes as presented. Commissioner Head 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Carried 5-0
3. Audience with Individuals, no one signed up to speak.
4. C & A on Accounts Payable: Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve Accounts Payable; Commissioner Sullivan provided the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Carried 5-0

5. C & A on TAC CIRA Services Agreement – Jason Bram was present to answer any questions. We are staying with the same company just updating for ADA Compliance. There will be a one-time migration fee, but it will be divided into two payments. There is a significant increase in the cost of this service but will be spread out over two years. This is not in the budget for this year, and the County will wait until next budget cycle to implement this. We will do what we can in advance to ensure an easy migration. There is no action to be taken at this time since we will be waiting for the next budget cycle. Commissioner Partin made a motion to Table this item for a later date, Commissioner Head 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Carried 5-0
6. C & A on Camera Bids for the LEC. David Sons is present to discuss the Bids for Cameras at the LEC. He would like to put together panel and interview the top two candidates. Commissioner Williams made the motion to set up a panel to interview the top two candidates for Camera bids at the LEC. Judge Johnson 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Carried 5-0
7. C & A on writing a new RFP for Mills County LEC Cameras. There was no action taken on this matter.
8. C & A on Resolution for Law Enforcement Grant Senate Bill 8: Sheriff Jones was present to explain a little about this grant. He stated that it will follow the same guidelines as Senate Bill 22. Judge Johnson made the motion to approve the Resolution, Commissioner Williams 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Carried 5-0
9. C & A on Budget Amendments: Commissioner Williams made the motion to go into executive session Government Code Section 551.074 and Section 551.075 to discuss employee matters. Judge Johnson 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Carried 5-0 . Court entered Executive

Session at 9:37am. Court is back in session at 10:12 am. Commissioner Williams made the motion to Table the Budget Amendment, Commissioner Head 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Carried 5-0

10. C & A on a line-item transfer for Precinct 4. There was a miss figure during budget. Judge Johnson made the motion to approve the line-item transfer, Commissioner Sullivan provided the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Carried 5-0
11. Discuss having a workshop meeting for Road and Bridge Projects. Commissioner Williams recommended a workshop to discuss materials and to include shared equipment and the bids for the low water crossing. February 19<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 pm
12. Discuss shared and precinct equipment issues: Will be discussed in the Workshop on February 19<sup>th</sup>.
13. Discuss going out for bids for Low water crossing: Will be discussed in the Workshop on February 19<sup>th</sup>.
14. Commissioner Request and Reports:
  - PCT 1- Work on equipment, finished work on CR 317 and worked on CR 318
  - PCT 2- Tree clean up from the ice storm, work on equipment, and did some blading
  - PCT 3- Replaced Batteries that were stolen off equipment, The concrete on the bridge on CR 508 is complete and working on side rails.
  - PCT 4- Have to wait for the Bridge on CR 508 to be completed before we can finish the work on CR 433. Got some right-of -way work done on 527, worked on equipment. Rick Pickard is officially retired.
