## Get Ready To Vote By Mail

### YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE BY MAIL IF YOU MEET ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:



65 years or older



Sick or disabled



Confined in jail, but are  
otherwise eligible



Expected to give birth  
within three weeks of  
Election Day



Out of the county on  
Election Day and during  
the period for early  
voting by  
personal appearance



Civily committed under  
Chapter 841 of the Texas  
Health and Safety Code

### VOTING BY MAIL IN TEXAS

The first step is to fill out an Application for Ballot by Mail (ABBM). You can find and print the application at [VoteTexas.gov](http://VoteTexas.gov) or request one from your county's election office.

On your ABBM and mail ballot carrier envelope, you must provide either:

1. Your Texas Driver License, Personal ID, or Election Identification Certificate number; OR
2. The last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.

*You are welcome to provide both numbers. If you have not been issued one of these numbers, you must indicate that by checking the appropriate box on the ABBM or carrier envelope.*
