INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

Mills County is requesting competitive bids for **hauling road base materials** for county road maintenance and construction projects.

Materials may include:

- Crushed limestone
- Flex base
- Road base aggregate
- Reclaimed asphalt pavement (RAP)
- Other similar materials

Materials will typically be transported from:

- Quarries
- Gravel pits
- Material stockpiles

Delivery locations will generally be **county roads or county storage areas within Mills County**.

Term of Contract

The contract will be for:

One (1) year

Beginning upon approval by the **Mills County Commissioners Court** to the end of the fiscal year, September 30, 2026.

Scheduling of Work

Hauling services will be requested **as needed** by Mills County precincts.
The County **does not guarantee a minimum amount of work**.

Equipment Requirements

All trucks and trailers must:

- Be suitable for hauling road materials
- Use **belly dump trailers capable of controlled spreading**
- Be in safe operating condition
- Meet all **Texas DOT and DPS regulations**

Drivers must possess valid licenses required for commercial operation.
